RE: APPROVAL UNDER THE "RECYCLER QUALIFICATION PROGRAM FOR END-OF-LIFE ELECTRONICS RECYCLING" (RQP) 2010

This notice confirms that ELECTRO-SHRED LTD., has successfully completed the audit process under the "Recycler Qualification Program" (RQP) 2010.

As such, the following operations, in combination with the downstream recyclers and processes defined in the attached material flow, have been approved for use under Electronic Products Recycling Association (EPRA) programs:

Manual dismantling of electronics, removing substances of concern and manually separating material streams. Hard drives and other data containing devices are destroyed via a shredder.

This approval is granted specific to the scope of operations identified above, and is valid for a maximum period of two years from the date of issuance of this letter, after which re-audit is required. In addition, all downstream vendors are also subject to re-audit under the RQP 2010 and must be found to be operating in conformance with the requirements in order to maintain this approval.

Should you wish to change the scope of this approval prior to its expiration (any materials processed, downstream recyclers or any processing method), a subsequent assessment and approval is required prior to undertaking any changes for processing any EPRA program material.
